The Prophet's Sacrifices for His Ummah

- Let us look at the sacrifices made by our Prophet s.a.w to ensure that the message of Tauhid is transmitted to all mankind, how patient and steadfast our Prophet was in practicing Islam and spreading dakwah.
- Our Prophet faced lots of resistance and confrontation to his dakwah that begin from his own paternal uncle, Abu Lahab to the hostilities shown by the unbelievers in Mekkah to all Muslims in general.
- When more and more people embraced Islam and the unbelievers in Mecca decided to take some drastic action they made an agreement among all the tribes of Mecca, to boycott the clan of Bani Hashim the clan the Prophet belongs to with the exception of Abu Lahab. The boycott will continue until Bani Hashim themselves give up giving sanctuary to Prophet Muhammad s.a.w.
- Our blessed Prophet s.a.w and his companions were tortured and received much hostility for believing in Allah and practicing Islam. He did not know the word whining, complaining and did not know the word terrorism and violence. But he taught his followers to face challenges with patience and raising our hand to Allah asking for His assistance and the Prophet continued to contribute all things good to show good virtue in the face of evil.
- This is what we should instill in ourselves and our family members. Teach them to emulate our Prophet and remind them that our Prophet s.a.w had sacrificed a lot for us. Remind that all the teachings of our Prophet will lead to happiness and prosperity.
- This is one of the sacrifices that we must make for our beloved Prophet s.a.w. Sacrifices in teaching our family the love to our Prophet s.a.w that brought blessings and peace to all. Hopefully with such sacrifices our children and our wives will love our Prophet s.a.w more.
