Rasulullah's Principles in Dealing With Society

- It is importantly for us to understand Rasulullah's life, his teachings and implementing them in our daily lives. This is what is required of us to truly be the ummah which Rasulullah s.a.w would acknowledge.

- The main principle in Rasulullah's interactions with the society, regardless whether the person was a Muslim or a non-Muslim, was to treat him well, with respect and kindness

- Rasulullah s.a.w was a man who loved all Allah's creation very much, Muslims and non-Muslims. Animals or man. This is the human characteristic in Rasulullah s.a.w, which made him a mercy to mankind.

- Rasulullah s.a.w was said that he respected the deceased as a man, who was a Jew, as he is a descendent of Prophet Adam who deserved respect

- In our daily lives, we are not free from being tested by the behaviour and habits of the people around us, who at times make us angry, agitated, irritated, or sad. This is part and parcel of life.

- Third those who loved him, Rasulullah s.a.w would respond by praying for their safety and well-being, and advising them kindly when they committed mistakes and for those who hated him, Rasulullah would respond with kindness.

- May we get guidance from the history of Rasulullah s.a.w. And may our community, by doing that, be a more harmonious, and an excellent community respected by others.
