WISDOM in the LIFE of MUSLIM

- Last week, we were introduced to one of the key attributes of the messengers of Allah s.w.t. which is amanah (trustworthiness).
- Another key attribute of theirs is wisdom, a sharp mind, and a very good understanding and knowledge of the world around them. Thus, one of their key attributes is *fathonah* or wisdom.
- Wisdom stands on a few pillars: First is the ability to understand and analyse a problem or situation. When we face a challenge, as believers, we should try to investigate the roots of the problem.
- Secondly, a wise *mukmin* and one who is confident of his faith will not miss the opportunity of learning from others or listening to other views and ideas which will help improve his life in this world, and also his life in the hereafter.
- Thirdly, wisdom also requires of us to be aware and cognisant of developments around us that will affect us one way or another. With such awareness, one can plan to face any possibility in life.
