### A MUSLIM DUTY TOWARDS ALLAH'S CREATION

- Allah s.w.t has created this world in all its splendour of beauty and richness and placed man in this world, together with millions of other animals and living things. He created the heavens with a multitude of orbiting objects in outer space, the stars, the planets, the moons and galaxies.
- It is an obligation upon us to think of such creations not only because it is a command from Allah s.w.t. but more importantly it intensifies our faith in Allah s.w.t, it strengthens our taqwa to Allah s.w.t, and it helps us to instill khusyu' in our ibadah.
- Every single thing is created by Allah s.w.t with a reason. Every creation of Allah s.w.t. is a sign and evidence of His Existence, His Oneness and His Might.
- Our physical body is enough evidence for the existence of Allah, His Might. Our body is actually not our possession. It belongs to Allah s.w.t. and our Ruh, spirit, is merely loaned to this body. Our body belongs to Allah s.w.t and He has loaned it to us and Allah s.w.t has laid down certain rules in using the body.
- As Muslims we have an advantage because Allah s.w.t has sent down to us the best judicial system. Not just to guide us in our ibadah but also to guide us in performing our duties as vicegerents of Allah. And as vicegerents, our first duty is to ensure the prosperity of this world, and not its destruction.
- This is in line with the characteristic of Islam itself as rahmatan lil-'alamin, a blessing to the world.
