### OBSERVING IHSAN TO ALL

- Be mindful of our prayers and the prayers of those who are under our responsibility. Ensure that we are not the only ones who pray, but our wives and our children pray too because we will be asked by Allah s.w.t about their prayers.
- Life as a Muslim is a life which brings blessings to all because it is described in Rasulullah's hadith as: Which means: A Muslim is someone whom others are safe from the actions of his tongue and his hand. And the person who commits hijrah is the one who leaves behind all that is forbidden by Allah s.w.t.
- This is the lowest level of Ihsan for Muslims. Which is not to harm other Muslims. Besides this lowest level of ihsan, is the act of ihsan that is displayed such as empathy, polite, courteous and helping other people within one's means.
- Among the many categories of people whom Allah s.w.t has mentioned in being Ihsan to, Allah s.w.t started with mentioning ihsan for parents. This is because they are the closest and the most important people to us and their sacrifices cannot be exchanged with money.
- Allah s.w.t mentioned clearly in the Al-Quran which means: *Your Lord has commanded that you worship none but Him, and that you show kindness to parents. If one or both of them attain old age with you, never say to them as much as ugh nor reproach them, but always address them with kindly speech.*
- This is among the many ways of ihsan we can show to our parents. We need to show ihsan to other people too, regardless of race or religion. Rasulullah s.a.w said: Those who show ihsan will receive blessings from Allah Who is Most Loving. Show ihsan to all in this world, indeed Allah will show ihsan to you.
