IMPORTANCE of TABLIGH as an ATTRIBUTE in OUR LIVES

- In the past weeks, all of us had listened to the sermons regarding the first three attributes which are *amanah* (trustworthiness), *fatolah* (wisdom) and *sidq* (truthfulness).
- Today, we will be discussing another attribute which is just as important. It is non other than the attribute of *tabligh*.
