### THE VALUE of TRUSTWORTHINESS (AMANAH) in ISLAM

- The Prophet s.a.w. himself reminded us about being trustworthy with many reminders, as we have heard in the previous week's sermon. It is therefore clear to us that trustworthiness is a huge part of our religious belief and practice.
- Let us therefore be trustworthy to Allah s.w.t. We should not be negligent in carrying out our duties to Him. This also means we should not carry out our duties half-heartedly, whether these are our ritual practices, such as solat, or our social relationships with others.
- Let us also be trustworthy to the Holy Prophet Muhammad s.a.w. This requires of us to strengthen our relationship with him as the leader of our religious belief and practice.
- Let us also uphold trustworthiness in family life. We must become responsible and trustworthy parents. We work to find a halal income, and we give the best education to our children. We must also uphold the trust of our wives to us.
- Trustworthiness cannot be separated from iman. A true mukmin and believer is a trustworthy individual. He can be trusted, and everyone is at ease with him. Because without trustworthiness, our character is meaningless.
