### Islam the Religion of Brotherhood

- Muslims should not be jealous of each other, do not cheat other people, do not hate each other, do not bear enmity against each other, and do not try to unreasonably excel one another.
- All Muslims are brothers to each other. This brotherhood is not bounded by nationality, skin colour, race, language or culture. And as brothers, we are prohibited from committing injustice to our own brothers. Especially fighting, killing, humiliating and other acts. These are considered as big sins.
- Brotherhood in Islam is based on love and helping each other. This affection shown will motivate us to help our brothers in need.
- When we see our own brothers quarrelling or fighting, we have to make peace between them by advising them to be patient.
- Allah s.w.t has commanded us to be kind not to Muslims only. But to all of mankind, by respecting his choice of religion and by treating him as a person with human rights. We are not allowed to be too proud to listen to good advice or seek knowledge from non Muslims, as wisdom and advice from Allah s.w.t may not come from Muslims only. It may even come from wrongdoers, what more from non Muslims who are not in enmity with us.
