GOOD MORAL & CONDUCT IS OUR IDENTITY

- Good moral values are our identity Our Prophet Muhammad s.a.w has shown us good morals that are complete and comprehensive. It includes projection of our self, interactions, and our deeds, with fellow Muslims, and non-Muslims.
- As an employer, the Prophet s.a.w was most understanding. This was acknowledged by a companion who used to serve him, Anas r.a, who said: I used to serve the Prophet s.a.w for 10 years. By Allah, he has never say “uff” to me and he never said to me: “Why did you do such and such, or Why not you do such and such?”
- In his interaction with other people, the Prophet s.a.w always said good things or he would remain silent. He never lied even when he jokes. When handling conflict the Prophet s.a.w preferred to forgive rather than exact revenge to others.
- The Prophet s.a.w did not like to waste time. And he dislike his companions and his followers to waste their time idling their time away along roads.
- The Prophet s.a.w also cared much on his appearance. He would combed his hair, wore neat clothes. But he abstained from expensive clothes, and he never showed off with his clothing.
- The Prophet s.a.w was also very health conscious. He would not eat until he was hungry. And he would stop eating before he felt full
- These are part of the good morals and conduct shown by our Prophet s.a.w. We must emulate them and be part of our identity. The Islamic identity that is full of compassion and love.
