Iman Guided By Knowledge

- A person's "taqwa" is measured by his Iman. If his Iman increases, so does his Taqwa, thus it will motivate the individual to perform more good deeds. However, if his Iman decreases, so does his Taqwa; that will cause the individual to do more wrong.
- Therein lies Prophet Ibrahim's principles. He taught his people on having Iman in Allah, through observation of the constellation.
- The correct way to educate ourselves to gain a deeper knowledge of Allah. In fact we, as Allah's creations are proofs of Allah's Greatness. This method is also good to teach our children to know Allah.
