### THE IMPORTANCE OF SUPPLICATION

- The prayer and supplication of a servant to his Lord, is a very important tool, which we might not have realized, a tool that can be used in times of calmness and peace, or in times of need and adversity as du'a is regarded as the Mother of all Ibadah
- Anything that we pray to Allah SWT for will be granted, as this is Allah's promise. Allah will grant our prayers accordingly or He will grant us with something better.
- Allah's promise to grant all our prayers it induce calmness and happiness to the believers. It provides hope and faith into the hearts of Believers. Thus a Muslim will then sincerely submit to the Will of Allah swt
- We wish for our prayers to be answered, we should take care of the purity of our soul. We will have to be careful of what we eat, drink and wear. Even though the prayer of one who is in Musafir is never denied, a du'a which comes from unclean and impure soul might be rejected.
- Other than du'a and efforts, the way we pray to Allah is also important. We are therefore urged to seek the suitable moments where our prayers can be easily granted. The first is the prayer supplicated at night and also secondly, a du'a uttered between the azan and iqamat as Rasulullah SAW said:: A du'a between an azan and an iqamat will not be denied.
- Above all, this is the moment where we have submitted all our efforts in striving to achieve our goal to the will of Allah SWT. This is thus the faith and submission to Allah SWT. This is the peak of our du'a. For it is only Allah SWT whom we worship, and from Him do we seek Help.
